The map supplied with the application (Appendix 1) shows only three other masts in the area. The cover letter states "a further search for telecom masts and towers was undertaken on SDCC planning website, however no additional structures were identified." The area as you will see in the image highlights one particular region where there are three masts and essentially crops out the other masts in the region.

However, maps I found on the ComReg Site Viewer website show the additional masts in the area(see Appendices 2,3,4 attached) These masts and equipment are <u>not</u> included in SD22A/0445 application.

This is a misleading representation of the masts in the area. It is used to frame the application for the mast as being "required in this area of Lucan to provide improved coverage."

The 1996 guidelines for Planning Authorities on Telecommunications Antennae and Support Structures state that "The support structure should be kept to the minimum height.... and should be monopole (or poles) rather than a latticed tripod or square structure." The plan was for a tripod type structure. The coverage of the trees was given as a reason for approval of this mast. The trees first only provide cover for the part of the year. The mast will also be above the tree-line.

The photos taken from Cannonbrook are from the summer when trees in full bloom. My house overlooks the park and I have four windows the will have a clear view of the tower.

The guidelines also states that "Only as a last resort should free-standing masts be located in a residential area or beside schools. If such a location should become necessary, sites already developed for utilities should be considered"

This location is clearly <u>not</u> a last resort and an alternative location on existing sites should be considered.

I have also included petition with 120 signatures objecting to this planning permission.
