Condituion 12:

Tree and Hedgerow Protection Measures
Prior to the commencement of development, the
applicant/developer shall submit a tree protection plan for
the written agreement of the Planning Authority, following
consultation with SDCC's Public Realm Section if required.
Tree protection measures shall be shown on a layout plan
accompanied by descriptive text and shall include:

- (a) The location of the trees to be retained and their root protection areas and canopy spreads (as defined in BS 5837: 2012 Trees in relation to design, demolition and construction);
- (b) The position and construction of protective fencing around the retained trees (to be in accordance with BS 5837: 2012 Trees in relation to design, demolition and construction).
- (c) The extent and type of ground protection, and any additional measures required to safeguard vulnerable trees and their root protection areas.
- (d) An arboricultural impact assessment which evaluates the direct and indirect impacts of the proposed development on the trees to be retained and proposed mitigation.
- (e) An arboricultural method statement to demonstrate that operations can be carried out with minimal risk of adverse impact on trees to be retained.



(f) A method statement for any works proposed within the root protection areas of the trees shown to be retained.(g) A meeting with the Project Landscape Architect, Site

Foremen, the appointed Arborist and a Parks
Superintendent form the Public Realm Section shall take
place on-site to inspect that:

i. all tree pruning & tree felling has been carried out appropriately and

ii. that the protective fencing has been erected prior as per the submitted Tree Protection Plan This fencing is to remain in place for the duration of the project.

The approved tree protection measures shall be retained in situ until the development has been completed.

REASON: In order to ensure adequate protection for the trees and hedges on the site during the construction of development, and in the interests of the visual amenity of the

area.

Planner's response:

The Public Realm Section have reviewed the information and state that it is acceptable, and the applicant is therefore in compliance. The Public Realm Section recommend that the compliance submission is agreed.
