- 1.1 It is unclear what volume of surface water can be stored in the proposed SuDS. Submit a drawing in plan and cross-sectional views showing proposed SuDS. The drawing should include the capacity what volume in m³ which can be stored in proposed SuDS.
- 1.2 Submit a report showing site specific soil percolation test results to clarify what water storage capacity is required to be attenuated in proposed SuDS to match the pre-developed greenfield run off rates on site.
- 1.3 Submit a revised drawing in plan and cross-sectional views to show overflow connections of proposed SuDS (rainwater garden, planter boxes, tree pits) up to the point of connection to a public surface water sewer network.

- The Developer shall ensure that there is complete separation of the foul and surface water drainage for the proposed development.
- All works for this development shall comply with the requirements of the Greater Dublin Regional Code of Practice for Drainage Works.

Note: Surface water should be attenuated on site to pre-developed greenfield run off rates in accordance with the Greater Dublin Strategic Drainage Study (GDSDS) Volume 2- New Development requirements.

Surface water should be attenuated by means of SuDS, therefore surface water should be dealt with through infiltration rather than underground attenuation.
