## **Report from Water Services, SDCC**

Report from SDCC Water Services 21/04/2023 with the following comments:

-Water Services are not satisfied that Condition 4 of SD22A/0293 is being complied with. ' The Surface Water on the submitted drawing is still shown to connect to the Foul Water System. There is a surface water line running on the opposite side of the road to the front of the property, if the existing water line from the property is blocked/dead leg (as indicated on the drawings), a new connection should be applied for to connect surface water to the existing 300mm surface water line.

## **Planners Comments:**

As per report from SDCC Water Services, the submission is **not** in compliance with Condition 4 of SD22A/0293. The submission shows the surface water is shown to connect to the foul water system. A new connection should be applied for to connect surface water to the existing 300mm surface water line.

## **Conclusion**

The submission is **not** considered to comply with Condition 4. "
