Report from Roads Department, SDCC – Roads Department are not satisfied that Condition 36(iii) is being complied with. The report received with regard to the proposed development stated the following:

"The road safety audit feedback form does not note the problem 2.3. it is not clear if the issue of parking beside a grass verge has been accepted.

Do not agree compliance submission.

The applicant should submit a road safety audit where the designer has completed the feedback form".

Response:

Client confirms that the problem identified in No. 2.3 has been accepted and solution has been addressed with landscaping removed and a hard surface has been added to facilitate movement of people between car parking bays and adjoining footpath.
